## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Attempts to set 5" OD liner from 7254' to 7560' were unsuccessful and the liner was finally set and cemented from 7325' to 7743' using 418' of 5" OD liner. After waiting forty-eight hours, top of cement was found @ 7741'. The 5" liner and cement were then tested with 1000# pressure applied for 30 minutes - no pressure drop. After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil & Gas Inspector, preparations are being made to perforate liner and complete the well.
