On July 9 & 10, 1949, ran 227 jts of new 7" OD, 8 Rd. Thd., 23#, N-80 and J-55, SS casing. From bottom up: 47 jts of N-80, R-3 casing with long T & C, 180 jts of J-55, R-2 casing with short T & C, and one 7" Baker casing centralizer set @ 7370'. Tallies 7361', H-13', set @ 7374'. Cemented by Halliburton w/575 sacks of 2% Howcogel and 125 sacks of common Portland bulk cement. Plug @ 7331'. Job started @ 9:55 p.m. and completed @ 8:20 a.m.

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off @ 8:20 a.m., July 12, 1949.
