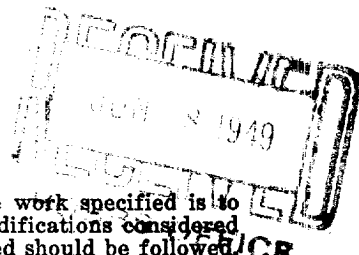

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off @ 11:30 p.m. June 5, 1949.
