Gentlemen:

According to a sundry report received on the above-referenced well the Paddock zone was squeezed and the Blinebry zone perforated at 5457--5797'.

As of this date we have received no recompletion C-104 or C-105 covering this work.

I do not know what GOR the Blinebry zone in #9 has but if it is classified as an oil well you will need to have the gas proration unit currently dedicated to your J.N. Carson NCT-C #6-I reduced by the deletion of Unit I. If the #9 GOR classifies the well as gas you will need to obtain approval of a non-standard location and simultaneous dedication of the #9 to the existing 120-acre proration unit currently dedicated to your #6-P.

Your prompt attention to this matter will be appreciated.
