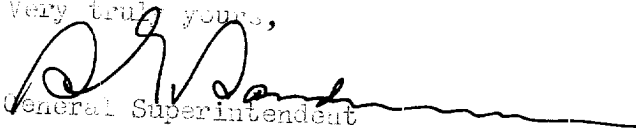

Dear Sir:

Under date of April 9, I sent you executed Form C-101 - Notice of Intention to Drill, on our Eunice King well No. 1, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico. This was approved under date of April 11, 1936. In this report, we advised you that the 7-5/8" casing would be landed at a depth of 1500' and cemented with 325 sacks of cement. This has been changed, and the 7-5/8" casing, as you will note by the attached "Notice of Intention to Drill", will be landed at a depth of 2700 feet and cemented with 325 sacks of cement.
