On December 9, 1946, the 7" OD 23# 8 rnd thd new A.O. Smith SS casing was set at 6500' Line. Cemented with 575 sac 2% Aquagel and 125 sac Atlas neat bulk cement, by Halliburton. Plug pumped to 6451'. Job started at 4 AM, completed at 3 PM, Dec. 9, 1946.

Propose to drill plug and test shut off at 3.00 PM Dec. 12, 1946.
