Tallies 7734', H-13', set @ 7747'. Cemented by Halliburton with 575 sacks 2% BONCO Jel and 125 sacks common Portland bulk cement. Plug @ 7688'. Job started @ 11:45 a.m. and completed @ 8:40 p.m.

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off @ 8:40 p.m., February 27, 1949.
