After waiting 48 hours, the casing was tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 minutes, and tested OK. The plug was not drilled, and after approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were being made to plug back and perforate the 7" casing.
