- 1. Drilled from Plugged Back Total Depth 7721' to 7880'.
- 2. Ran Schlunberger ES and Microlog Surveys.
- 3. Ran 2-3/8" tubing set at 7829!, packer at 7734'. Well swabbod down.
- 4. Ran straddle packers set at 7850' and 7875'. Attempted to treat Connell
- sand with 250 gallons MCA acid. Was unable to treat formation.
- 5. Reran tubing. Returned well to production
