DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After waiting forty-eight hours, the casing was tested with 1000 pounds pressure, applied for 30 minutes. The plug was drilled and the casing and cement were tested with 1000 pounds applied for 30 minutes. Both tests were OK, and after approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
