DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The 13 3/8 and 9 5/8 casing was left in the well as cement had been circulated in both strings. The well was filled with 9.1 mud and the McKee Sand was cemented with 50 sacks from a total depth of 7941' to approx. 7841'. A 100 sack plug was placed from 6740' to 6440' to protect the Drinkard pay and the well was then capped with an 80' cement plug. 4" pipe cemented in the cap will protrude 4' above the surface of the ground.
