## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After waiting forty-eight hours, the casing was tested with 1000# pressure applied for 30 minutes. The plug was drilled and the casing and cement were tested with 1000# pressure applied for, 30 minutes. Both tests were OK, and after approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to complete the well.

Top of cement back of 7" casing at 2850' per temperature survey.
