DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After waiting 48 hours, the casing was tested with 1000# of pressure applied for 30 minutes. The plug was not drilled. There was a plug back from 7665' to 7630'. The test showed no drop in pressure and after the approval of Mr Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to complete the well.
