## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has been producing from Penrose-Skelly formation since June 1, 1936. The initial production test after treating W/8000 gal. acid was 44 bbls. per day. At present well is flowing approximately 4 bbls. per day.

Following is a record of casing in well:

10-3/4" OD @ 288', cemented W/250 sacks.  
7" OD @ 3592', cemented W/375 sacks.

It is The Ohio Oil Company intention to drill this well deeper to test the Drinkard Zone. Will case and cement off old pay zone from 3592' to T. D. 3800'. Rotary tools will be used from present depth to approximately 6600'. 5" OD extreme casing will be set at approximately 6450' and cemented W/500 sacks.
