## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED


Pulled tubing and re-ran to 3,731 ft., with standing valve at 3,535 ft.,  
packer in 7-inch casing at 3,515 ft., unloading valve at 3,509 ft., and six John  
R. Long used flow valves at 3,101, 3,072, 3,055, 2,837, 1,715 and 1,590 ft.

Results: Reduced gas-oil ratio from 50,984:1 to 6,041:1. Tested well for  
24 hours, 11:00 AM October 22 to 11:00 AM October 23: Oil produced, 31.33 bbls.;  
water produced, none; gas produced, 199,262 cu. ft.; gas-oil ratio, 6,041:1.
