Dear Mr. Porter:

The Ohio Oil Company respectfully requests that you grant this application for authority to dually complete its Mr. H. Turner Well No. 3, located 1980' FSE and 340' FEL, Section 29, T-21-S, R-37-E. The Mr. H. Turner Well No. 3 was originally completed on October 1, 1949, as an oil well producing from the Hare Oil Pool. In June, 1956, the well was plugged back and recompleted as a single completion gas well producing from the Blinberry Gas Pool. The Ohio Oil Company now desires to dually complete the well in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tubb Gas Pool through the tubing and gas from the Blinberry Gas Pool through the production casing-tubing annulus. Ohio intends to install an artificial barrier between the two zones and to perform the completion so as to prevent waste in each reservoir. A schematic diagram showing the proposed method for dually completing the well is attached. Subsequent to the completion, Ohio will present to the Commission data showing the detail completion program as well as plans for future testing which will be made regularly to determine that waste is not occurring in either reservoir.

The Ohio Oil Company further respectfully requests that you grant this application for the approval of the unorthodox location of the well in Section 29, and the designation and formation of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the N/2 of SE/4, Section 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, Tubb Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The Ohio owns the oil and gas leasehold estate on the acreage included in proposed gas proration unit, and the well to be dually completed in the Blinberry oil pool.

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New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order NSL-38, dated May 29, 1956, approved on Northbow well location for the No. 1 Turner Well, N. 1/4, Sec. 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, El Paso County, New Mexico, and New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order NSL-263, dated May 29, 1956, approved on 80-acre north-trending gas pool consisting of the N/2 of SE/4, Section 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

All acreage included in the proposed gas proration unit is located on the Northbow well location for the No. 1 Turner Well, N. 1/4, Sec. 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, El Paso County, New Mexico, and the Ohio landowner's estate with adjoining acreage. Unless the gas proration unit is formed, Ohio will be deprived of a fair share of the recovery of its just and equitable share of the natural gas from the gas pool. The formation of the proposed gas proration unit will not create any new rights and will not cause, but will prevent waste.

Enclosed is a schematic drawing which illustrates the location of the proposed gas proration unit, the well, and surrounding tracts. A copy of this drawing with the schematic drawing and plot has been sent by registered mail to the operators on the attached mailing list.

The Ohio therefore requests that you grant an exception to the applicable regulations for the Tubb Gas Pool, that the location of said well be approved, that this application be granted, and that the proposed gas proration unit be designated and formed by you without the necessity of hearing and pursuant to the provisions of the applicable rules and regulations, upon the expiration of thirty (30) days from this date.

Each and all of the foregoing statements are true and correct.
