## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Total Depth 6638' (PBTD 6631'). We propose to kill the well with water and set a hookwall packer at 6576' in 5" casing, thereby isolating the upper gas zone for reducing the producing GOR.

The perforated intervals below the packer will be 6576'-6588' and 6596'-6620'.

The perforated intervals above the packer will be 6524'-6534'; 6544'-6558'; and 6561'-6568'.

Our intention is to produce the well through the tubing.
