FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On May 25, at 5:00 PM, 30 hours will have elapsed since setting 6638' of 5" 15# New casing in subject well and cementing with 300 sacks, to be used for oil string at new depth.

At time mentioned, casing shut-off will be tested as follows:
A pressure of 1000# will be built up and held for thirty minutes, and if shut-off tests OK, cement plug will be drilled and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for thirty minutes. If this test, too, is OK, completion operations will be resumed.
