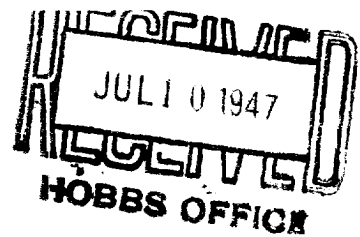

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On July 6th, 1947, at 6:00 P.M., 30 hours will have elapsed since setting 6625' of 4 1/2" OD new 11.6# casing in subject well and cementing with 400 sacks to be used for oil string. At the time mentioned above, casing shut-off will be tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# will be built up and held for thirty minutes, and if test is OK, cement plug will be drilled and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for thirty minutes. If this test, too, is OK, drilling operations will be resumed.
