Gentlemen:

Under the provisions of Order No. R-386, Rule 5 (d) 1., of the Special Pool Rules and Regulations for the Tubb Gas Pool, Stanolind Oil and Gas Company herewith makes application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit for its W. H. Turner Well No. 3, Unit P, SE/4 SE/4, Sec. 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, which has been recompleted in the Tubb Gas Pool.

In support of its application, Stanolind Oil and Gas Company furnishes the following information in compliance with Order No. R-586:

1. The non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections, namely the S/2 of SE/4 Sec. 29, T-21-S, R-37-E.
2. The non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Tubb Gas Pool.
4. The length or width of the non-standard gas proration unit does not exceed 2640 feet.
5. In lieu of sub paragraph (a) 5 of Rule 5, all offset operators are being notified by registered mail of our intent to form a non-standard gas proration unit. Attached is a mailing list of all operators notified.

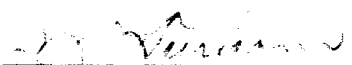

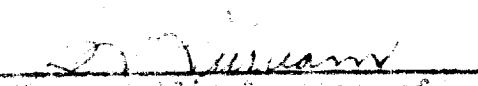
