Gentlemen:

Under the provisions of Order No. 10-373-A, of the Commission's rules and regulations, Standard Oil and Gas Company herewith makes application for administrative approval to drill, complete and produce its N. L. Turner No. 3, 6 1/4 x 7/8 Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P., Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner that gas from the Tubbs formation of the Tubbs Gas Pool may be produced through the casing-tubing annulus, and oil from the Olefina formation of the Santa-Abo Oil Pool through the tubing, by proper perforations and the installation of a suitable packer.

Further, under the provisions of Rule 4, Order No. 10-373-A, of the Commission's special pool rules for the Tubbs Gas Pool, Standard Oil and Gas Company herewith makes application for exception to Rule 3 of the aforementioned order, the necessity for the aforesaid location being occasioned by the recompletion of a well previously drilled to another horizon.

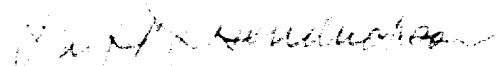
In support of this application, Standard Oil and Gas Company furnishes the following information in compliance with pertinent Commission memoranda:

1. This application is herewith submitted in triplicate.
2. Complete legal description of acreage involved: 6/2 of 1/4 Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P., Lea County, New Mexico.
3. Exact location and name of well involved: N. L. Turner No. 3,

located 500' from the south line and 700' from the east line of Section 27, Township 31 North, Range 37 East, 1934, Lea County, New Mexico.

- A. Attached is plat showing:
 - (a) acreage to be dedicated.
 - (b) well location.
 - (c) offset ownership.
- B. Attached is diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual completion showing:
 - (a) Formations involved.
 - (b) perforations.
 - (c) Approximate location of packer.
 - (d) Other information pertinent to the dual completion.
- C. Statement of intention: The subject well is presently being recompleted in the Gho formation (Santa-Abe Oil Pool horizon) after extensive repair operations failed to restore profitable production from the Musulman formation of the McDermick Oil Pool. Following recompletion in the Gho formation, it is proposed that casing be perforated opposite the Tubo formation of the Tubo Gas Pool and the well completed as a dual gas-oil producer in the Tubo Gas Pool and Santa-Abe Oil Pool, respectively.
- D. All operators who offset the lease upon which the subject well is located have been furnished a copy of this application by registered mail. Attached is mailing list of all operators notified.

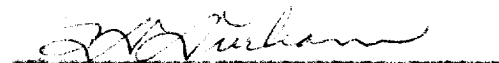

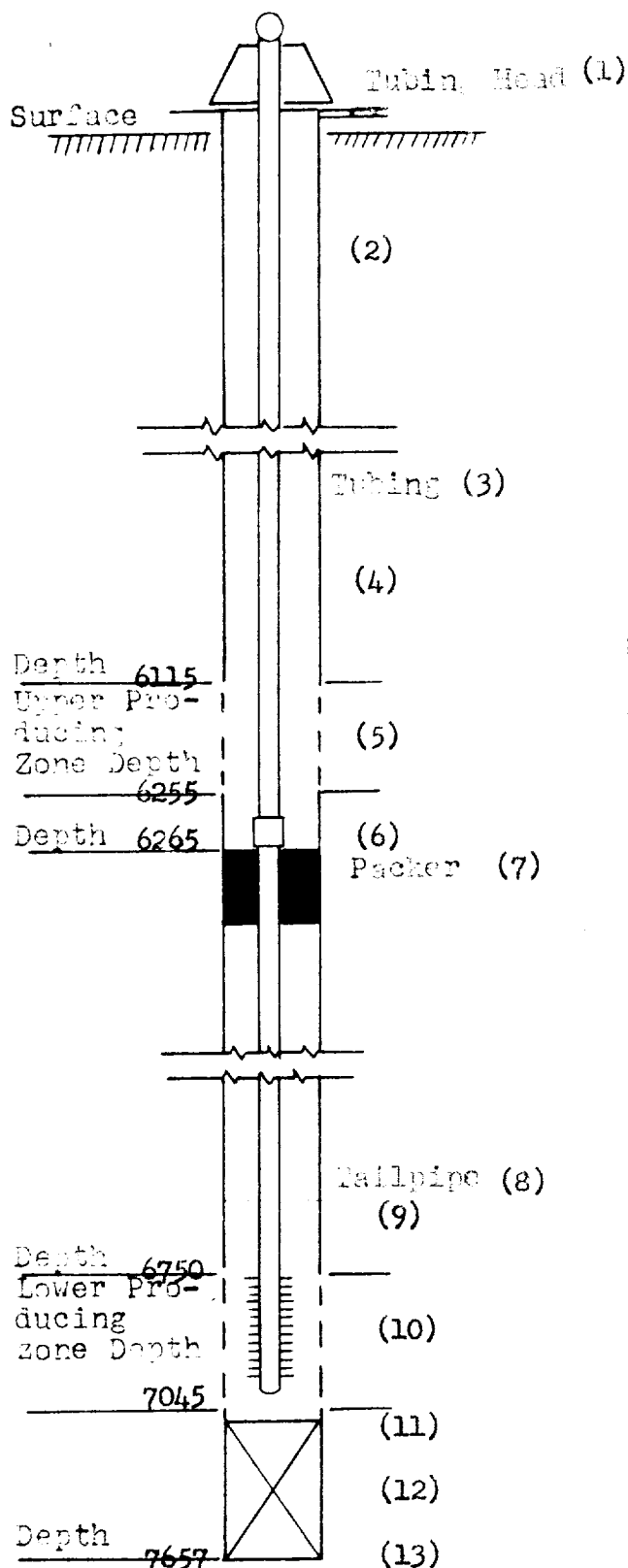
