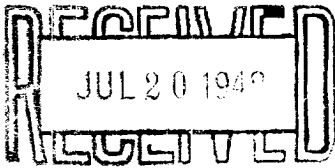

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On July 14, 1948, at 9:30 P.M. 30 hours had elapsed since running 7075 ' of 7 " new casing in subject well and cementing with 300 sacks to be used as oil string. At this time casing shut off was tested as follows: A pressure of 1000 # was built up and held for 30 minutes, testing OK. Cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 1000 # again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was OK. Drilling operations were resumed.
