Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the
Stanolind Oil & Gas Co. Company or Operator H. A. Turner Lease Well No. 3 in the
SE/4 of Sec. 29, T. 21-S, R. 37-E, N. M. P. M., McCormack Field, Lea County.

The dates of this work were as follows: May 10-12, 1948

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On May 12, 1948, at 3:00 a.m. 30 hours had elapsed since running 3004' of 9-5/8" new casing in subject well and cementing with 1200 sacks to be used as intermediate string. At this time casing shut off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000, was built up and held for 30 minutes, and test was OK. Cement plug was rilled and a pressure of 1000, again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was OK. Drilling operations were resumed.
