> Re: Application to Dually Complete and to establish a Standard Proration Unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool for Sinclair's H. S. Turner Well No. 3 in Section 29-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

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Sinclair Oil & Gas Company wishes to make this application for administrative approval under Order R-316, Rule 112A, to dually complete their H. S. Turner Well No. 3 in the Blinebry Gas Pool and the Drinkard Oil Pool (present zone).

Sinclair also wishes to make application for administrative approval under Order R=610 for a Standard Proration Unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool consisting of 160 acres located in the SW/4 of Section 29-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico to be assigned to subject well.

In the above matters Sinclair wishes to state:

- 1. Sinclair Oil & Gas Company is the operator of the H. S. Turner No. 3 Well which is located in the center of the SE/4 of the SW/4 of Section 29-215-37E. This well was completed as an oil well in the Drinkard Oil Pool on September 16, 1947 at a total depth of 6628 feet. Five and one-half inch casing was set at 6618 feet and cemented with 500 sacks and perforated in the Drinkard Oil zone from 6554 to 6604 feet. Top of cement behind the five and one-half inch production string was found at 2989 feet.
- 2. Sinclair proposes to dually complete subject well in the following manner:
 - a. Perforate the 52" casing from approximately 5577 feet to 5704 feet in the Blinebry Gas Pool.
 - b. Set a production packer below the Blinebry perforations at about 6500 feet to separate the two pay zones.
 - c. Produce the Blinebry gas through the casing-tubing annulus and the Drinkard oil through the tubing.
