

3. Sinclair will comply with all the rules and regulations of the Commission applicable to dual completions and the separation of pay zones.
4. Sinclair believes that the manner and method of this proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

The Standard Gas Proration Unit to be assigned subject well consists of the SW/4 of Section 29-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico. The well is located 660 feet from the East and South lines of the unit. The length or width of this unit does not exceed 2640 feet and it consists of a single governmental quarter section. The leasehold interest is common under the entire unit. All of the royalty interests under the North half of the unit (Sinclair's W. H. Turner Lease) and under the South half of the unit (Sinclair's H. S. Turner Lease) have executed lease amendments permitting the pooling of their interests in order to form the proposed gas proration unit. Subject unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Blinbry Gas Pool.

Sinclair believes that the granting of this application is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

Sinclair has notified all offset operators as defined in orders R-316 and R-610 of this application by copy thereof via registered mail. Said operators are listed on next page.

Sinclair, therefore, requests that this application, both for permission to dually complete and for the establishment of an 160 acre Standard Proration Unit in the Blinbry Gas Pool be granted by the Commission.
