TD 3803- Present production 20Bbl. oil & 6 barrel water- propose to clean-out to bottom, and drive lead wood to shut off water.

5/4/40- Went in hole with tools found top of Cavings @ 3773 and cleaned out to bottom.

5/15/40- Drove 500# lead wool in bottom- Tested for water shut off by bailing every hour. Tested dry as no water appeared in bailer each time bailer was pulled. Ran tubing preparing to test.

5/24/40- Flowed 40 barrel oil in 4½ hours- no water- W/ GOR 410/1
