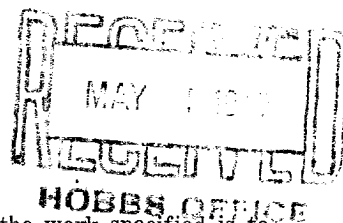

Company's C. Hardy Well No. 3 in NW/4  
Company or Operator Lease  
of Sec. 29, T. 21-S, R. 37-E, N. M. P. M., Penrose-Skelley Field.  
Lea County.

**FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK**

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has been producing from the Penrose-Skelley Field formation since December, 1938. The initial production was 100 bbls. per 24 hours after 200 quarts glycerin shot. The present production is 14 bbls. oil and 25 bbls. water per day.

Following is a record of casing in well:

9-5/8" OD casing @ 1239' w/226 sax.  
7" OD casing @ 3670' w/175 sax.

It is the Magnolia's intention to drill this well deeper to test the Drinkard Field Pay Zone. A Caliper Survey will be made, and if necessary, the shot hole will be cemented. Rotary tools will be used to drill a 6-1/4" hole from the present depth of 3810' to approximately 6650'. 5" OD casing will be set on bottom and cemented with 250 sax and perforated opposite the producing zone.
