FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Kill well with oil, pull tubing, set packer and Dolefrac through perforations 6587' to 6618' and test oil production. Run Baker D-5 Production packer and pressure test casing, load the hole with mud and lost circulation material, perforate in the Tubb Zone 6135' to 6160' and 6220' to 6310', acidize these sections separately with 500 gallons each and test separately. Then dual complete to produce oil from Drinkard Zone through tubing and gas from Tubb Zone through casing.
