2830' - Total Depth - Line - Run Temperature Survey - Top of cement behind 7-5/8" O.D. casing at 390', actual fill 2436', calculated fill 6923', ratio of actual to calculated fill 35.2%. Checked top of cement at 2742'. Tested casing & connections with 1000# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 2742' to 2830' & tested casing & connections with 1000# pressure for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Started drilling formation & 6-3/4" hole at 5:15 A.M., 7-25-50.

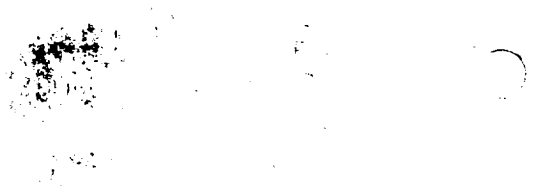
