On April 1, 1939, well was shot with 80 Qts L.N.G. and 222# DuPont chemical in eight 4-1/2" OD x 8' W.J. tin shells. A.G. Duplex 24 hour time bomb set for 24 hours at 3:14 PM placed at 3733' with Bolshovik Green cave catcher above. Broken brick to 3723', Sand to 3720'. Three sack Incor cement to 3699', sand to 3580' and 1 yd pea gravel to 3410', hole filled with water. Shot was placed from 3800' to 3736'.

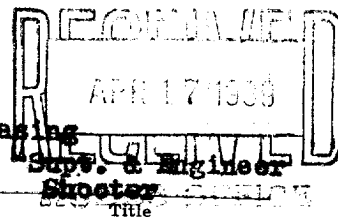
