Gentlemen:

The Mapenza Oil Company herewith applies for formation of a non-standard gas proration unit in an undesignated area (request has been made to extend the Arrow Gas Pool), Lea County, New Mexico, consisting of 160 acres being the SW/4 of Section 31, T21S, R37E. The Mapenza Oil Company #1 Gill well was drilled and completed in the vertical limits of the Arrow Gas Pool; exact location is 660' PSL and 660' FWL, Section 31, T21S, R37E. All rules and regulations of the Commission were followed in the drilling and completion of the well and applicable forms were filed, received, and approved by the Hobbs district office.

A plat is attached showing the acreage to be dedicated outlined in yellow. This plat also shows the well location, with distances from the section line and the offset ownership.

The Operator respectfully requests that the Commission grant his application for a non-standard proration unit in an undesignated area (request has been made to extend the Arrow Gas Pool), consisting of the above described 160 acres, for the following reasons:

1. The well is located in an undesignated area (request has been made to extend the Arrow Gas Pool), and completed in the vertical limits of the Arrow Gas Pool.
