Gentlemen:

Request is hereby made in accordance with the rules and regulations, for the approval of an exception to the "no-flare order". Subject well is known as the Tres Oil Company Gill A, located in the NW/4 Section 31, T-21S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico, and located in the Penrose-Skelly Pool. The description of the lease is the E/2 SW/4 and lots 3 and 4. In addition to the Gill A #1, there is a gas well located on the same lease, known as the Mapenza Gill #1 well. It is a gas well in the Mapenza Pool, and connected to Permian Basin Pipeline Company's high-pressure gas system. Line pressure is 450#.

Attached is a reproduction of a plat showing the well location, offset ownership, and location of the tank battery. Also attached is a letter from Skelly Oil Company, signed by Mr. L. L. Byars, manager of the gas division of the manufacturing department, which states the volume of the gas to be flared, and the distance from the nearest casinghead gas line. The operating gas-oil ratio on this lease is 320 cubic feet per barrel, and the well pumps. Also attached is a notarized affidavit stating that all statements of the application are true and accurate.
