Gentlemen:

A check of the file for your Gill "A" No. 1 in Unit L of Section 31, T-21-S, R-37-E indicates that you were notified by form letter dated February 5, 1958 that it would be necessary for you to either obtain a casinghead gas connection or secure a no-flare order for the well no later than March 31, 1958. According to our records you have as yet done neither, however.

In order to avoid allowable cancellation for the well, it will be necessary for you to either file Form C-110 showing a connection, or make application for a no-flare order at an early date.
