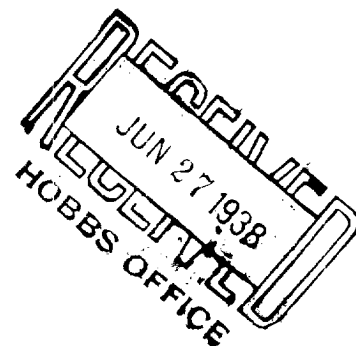

New 8-5/8" casing was set at 1193' in anhydrite and cemented with 600 sacks of cement on June 26th, 1938. Cement returned to the surface when the plug reached 800'. We intend to test the W.S.O. on June 28th, 1938.
