Proration Unit and Unorthodox
Location for Amerada State D"B"
No. 1, Tubb Gas Pool.

Gentlemen's letter of application Amerada Petroleum Corporation
is the following:

- wisw That Amerada Petroleum Corporation State D"B"
No. 1, located 1880 feet from the North line
and 2080 feet from the West line of Section 32,
Township 21 South, Range 37 East is a gas-oil
dual completed in the Tubb Gas Pool and Drinkard
Pool.
- (B) That the applicant proposes to assign this well
a non-standard gas proration unit in the Tubb
Gas Pool consisting of 80 acres which is the S/2
of the NW/4 of Section 32, Township 21 South,
Range 37 East. (Attached Exhibit "A")
 - (C) That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit
lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (D) That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit
may reasonably be presumed to be productive of
gas.
 - (E) That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit
does not exceed 2640 feet in length or width.
 - (F) That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit
consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
 - (G) That the unorthodox location, 560 feet from the
North and East boundary lines of the tract, was
occasioned by the dual completion of a well
previously drilled to the Drinkard Pool.
