FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Rig up, kill well, pull tubing and packer. Run Gamma Ray-Neutron Surveys. Perforate in Tubb Zone for gas production at 6090'-6210', subject to Gamma Ray-Neutron Surveys. Set Baker production packer on wire line and run tubing and side-door choke assembly with blank-off tool installed. Acidize Tubb Zone with 1,000 gallons mud acid and sand-oil down tubing and casing with 25,000 gallons refined oil and 25,000# sand. Swab to test. Re-place blank-off tool with separation sleeve, and re-complete as a dual well, producing oil from Drinkard Zone and gas from Tubb Zone.
