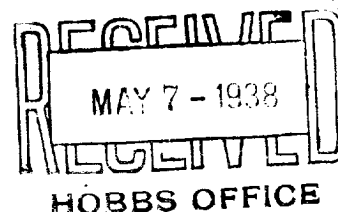

WARRANT FOR PERMIT TO TAKE WITH FIRE LINE

WHEREAS, the Commission has received a request from the applicant for a permit to take with fire line

and has considered the same and has determined that the same is in the public interest

IT IS ORDERED

that the permit be granted to the applicant

on the condition that the applicant shall comply with the following conditions

1. The applicant shall not take any more than the number of animals specified in the permit

2. The applicant shall not take any animals during the season when the animals are breeding

3. The applicant shall not take any animals in any area where the animals are protected

4. The applicant shall not take any animals in any area where the animals are scarce

5. The applicant shall not take any animals in any area where the animals are endangered

6. The applicant shall not take any animals in any area where the animals are rare

7. The applicant shall not take any animals in any area where the animals are common

8. The applicant shall not take any animals in any area where the animals are abundant
