Cemented with 650 Sx 2 1/2" and 125 Sx neat cement by Halliburton. Plug was pumped to 6469'. Job started 11.00 AM and completed 6.00 PM.

Propose to drill plug and test shut off at 6.00 PM October 6, 1946.

REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF THE BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

The following is a summary of the investigation conducted by the Bureau of Investigation into the activities of the Mexican Government in the United States during the year 1921.

The investigation was conducted by the Bureau of Investigation, United States Department of Justice, and was directed by the Commissioner of the Bureau, J. Edgar Hoover. The investigation was conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Espionage Laws of the United States, and was designed to determine the extent of the Mexican Government's activities in the United States during the year 1921.

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
