During July, 1944, Olsco Type K gas-lift system installed as follows:

Reran tubing, set at 3745', standing valve at 3719', 3" collecting chamber 3720' - 3630', 1" perforated collar at 3544', 375# bottom valve #1491 at 3523', 190'6" of 1" tubing 3523' - 3713'6", Lane-Wells Ring Type Hook Wall packer at 3561', 425# top valve #4002 at 3876'.

Production before: Well averaged 5 bbls. per day.

Production after: Flowed 8 bbls. of oil and no water in 24 hours. Gas injected 2 minutes out of every hour.
