Gentlemen:

In compliance with Rule 30, Order No. R-1670, which prohibits the simultaneous dedication of acreage to an oil and to a gas well, Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests exception to Rule 5 (a) of Order No. R-1670 for the approval of a non-standard 120-acre Blinebry gas proration unit covering the E/2 NE/4 and SW/4 NE/4 of Section 32, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

- (1) Gulf's W. T. McCormack Well No. 10, located 554 feet from the east line and 2086 feet from the north line of Section 32 is completed in the Blinebry Gas Pool and has been assigned a standard 160-acre gas proration unit, covering the NE/4.
- (2) Gulf's W. T. McCormack Well No. 12, located 554 feet from the north line and 1874 feet from the east line of this Section 32 has been recompleted as a Blinebry oil well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lies wholly within a single Governmental quarter section.
- (4) The entire non-standard proration unit is reasonably presumed to be gas productive in the Blinebry Gas Pool.
- (5) The length or width does not exceed 2640 feet.
