~~Casing~~ The hole was washed down and the casing tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 minutes. The plug was drilled and the casing tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 minutes. Both tests were OK, and after approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.

The temperature survey shows the top of cement behind the 9-5/8" casing at 1690' from the surface.
