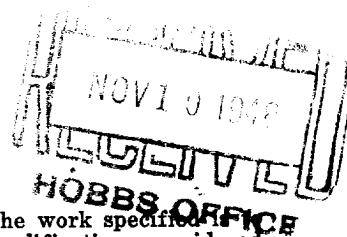

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off @ 11 p.m., November 9, 1948.
