Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Gulf Oil Corporation McCormack Well No. 15 in the Company or Operator Lease of Sec. 32, T. 21S, R. 37E, N. M. P. M., Drinkard Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After waiting forty-eight hours, the casing was tested with 1000# pressure applied for 30 minutes. The plug was drilled and the casing and cement were tested with 1000# pressure applied for 30 minutes. Both tests were OK, and after approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil & Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.

Top of cement back of 9-5/8" csg @ 1300' per temperature survey.
