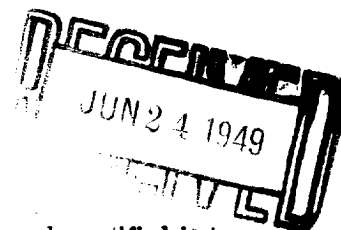

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off @ 10:20 p.m., June 24, 1949.
