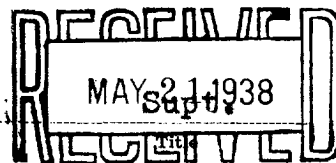
DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 3450, 3448' 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " 15# pipe were run with 400 sac cement. Heavy mud circulated. After 48 hours pipe tested 1200# O.K. Hole drilled to 3772'. 2150 gal. Dowell XX acid were run. Swabbed dry. On May 10th well was shot 500 qts. Nitro, E. I. du Pont de Nemours. Well cleaned itself. Well started flowing 30 boh, settled to 15 boh with 140,000 cu. ft. gas.
