

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6599' Drilled out depth, killed well with 125 barrels oil and 15 barrels water and lowered 2" Tubing to 6537' and set 5" x 2" American Type G Control Packer at 6530' and well started flowing while getting ready to swab.
On October 30, 1946 took 24 hour flow test on 1/4" Choke made 126.96 barrels oil 3/10% BS&W Casing Pressure 700#, Tubing Pressure 150#, Gas Volume 498M with Gas-Oil-Ratio of 3921. Well completed.
