6599' Drilled out depth, Killed well with 40 Bbls oil, pulled 2" Tubing, Gun Perforated from 6504-14-4 shots per foot total of 40 shots, ran tubing back in hole to 6527' and American Type G Control packer at 6520' (Loose in hole) pulled swab 12 times and well started flowing, flowed into pits 40 minutes and burned into tanks and in 24 hours on $\frac{1}{2}$ " Choke made 138.98 Bbls oil, 30.82 Bbls water, Daily Gas Volume 892M Gas-Oil-Ratio 6417.
