

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Gun perforated 3" OD Casing with 16 shots 6490 to 6494' and took drill stem test for 5 hours and recovered 50' of oil cut and and 10' Oil. Cement was OK and gun perforated from 6494 to 6504, 6515 to 6554, 6556 to 6600' with 4 shots per foot total of 352 shots, set 2" TUB Tubing at 6000' with 4' perforated Nipple at 6580' and swabbed well in and made 197.10 barrels oil in 14 hours 1/2" Choke Casing Pressure 65#, Tubing Pressure 25#, Gas Volume 166,200 cu. ft. Gas-Oil-Ratio 977. Well Completed.
