

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8160' Drilled out depth. Ran 500 gallons Western Mud Acid and well kicked off without swabbing. First hour flowed estimated 50 barrels into pits. Turned into tanks on 1/2" positive choke and for first 13 hour period well flowed 333.96 bbls. oil, 1/10% BS, no water. Gravity 40 at 64° corrected to 39.17 Gas volume 510,000 per day, GOR 826. Well complete.
