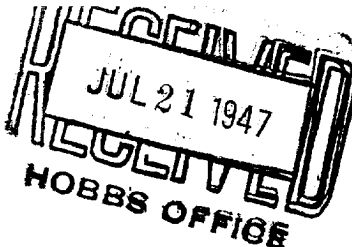

Cemented with 600 sacks El Toro Regular Cement and 50 sacks Incor Cement and plug pumped to 8080' at 5:20AM July 17, 1947, Final Pressure 1100#. Six Baker Centralizers set @ 8000', 8030', 8060', 8090', 8120' and 8150'.
